



Amputee Hockey Exhibition Game in Israel

An exhibition game between the International Standing Amputee Ice Hockey Federation (ISIHF) World Team with players from Russia, Canada, Finland, Czech Republic, Israel, and Latvia, and the Israel National Junior Hockey Team took place on August 1st, 2008, at the Canada Centre in Metula, Israel. The World team won 6-5. The game was to introduce Standing Amputee Hockey to the Israeli people and officials in anticipation that many people in Israel who are amputees will include ice hockey in their lives.

The ISIHF World Team joined the Israeli Paralympic delegation on August 3rd to meet with Shimon Peres, President of Israel. President Peres commended the ISIHF mission and emphasized an importance for the future development of Amputee Hockey in his country and beyond.
