A meeting on March 24th, 2009 took place during the Sportaccord 2009 in Denver, CO, USA, between Rene Fasel, IIHF President, Horst Lichtner, IIHF Secretary General, and Mark Pitkin, ISIHF President. The meeting was devoted to review of the current state of development of Standing Ice Hockey, structure of the ISIHF, and the ISIHF proposal for a tournament during Winter Paralympic Games of 2014 in Sochi, contingent IPC approval for inclusion of the sport of Standing Ice Hockey to the Paralympic Program.

Following Mark Pitkin presentation and the discussion between the participants, Mr. Fasel and Mr. Lichtner expressed their satisfaction with the international development of the Standing Ice Hockey, and the role played by the ISIHF in the process. Mr. Fasel confirmed the IIHF's continuing support to the Federation and the sport.
